HAV-Series Air Relief Check Valve

The HAV Series Air Relief Check Valve is installed vertically on suction lines where air removal is required.

The Dixon air relief valve is a double-seated valve with a freely moving polypropylene ball. The ball, which is lighter than water, closes against the upper or lower seat, against vacuum or positive pressure conditions. Under vacuum the ball sits at the bottom of the valve. Under positive pressure the ball moves allowing air to escape.






